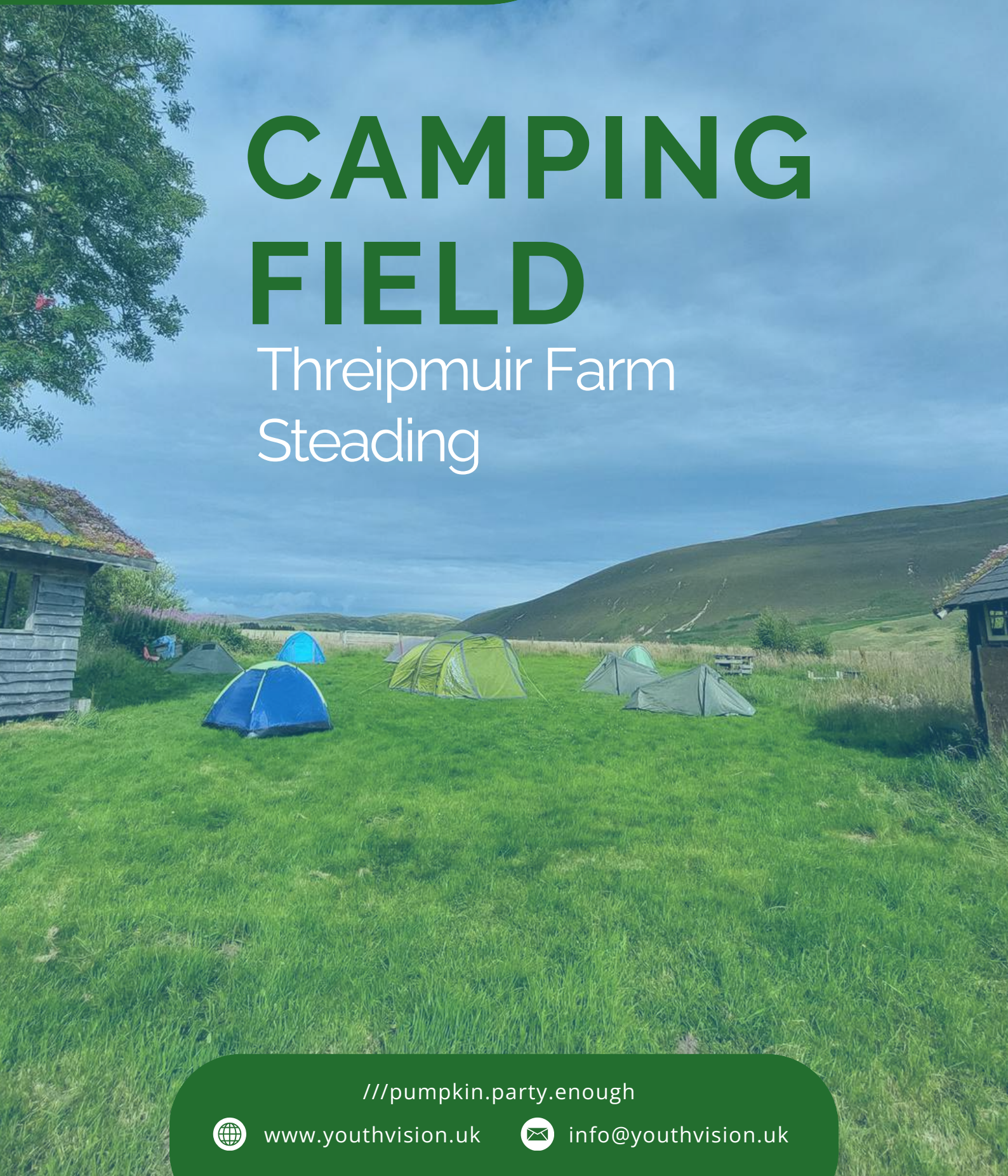

Threipmuir Farm Steading

Threipmuir steading came into existence in 1773 as part of the improvements in farming techniques then spreading through Scotland. It was last inhabited by a shepherd in the 1930's and was subsequently used as a weekend cottage.

Available for groups of up to 15 people, our camping field is a hidden gem. Nestled between the still waters of Threipmuir reservoir and the slopes of the Black Hill, it is the ideal base for adventure and exploration...

On the edge of the Pentland Hills



The Pentland Hills, a designated Regional Park, were formed 430 million years ago by volcanic activity and sedimentary deposits. Running along the south of Edinburgh they provide excellent hillwalking within easy reach of the city. The top of Allermuir Hill provides amazing views of the city and there is great ridge-walking along Carnethy Hill, Scald Law and the Kips. With numerous heather-covered slopes, deep valleys, and reservoirs there are plenty places to explore over the 16-mile range.



Just 100m from our camping field, Threipmuir Reservoir has a gentle slope and peaty water. It is the perfect place for a refreshing dip after a day in the hills!

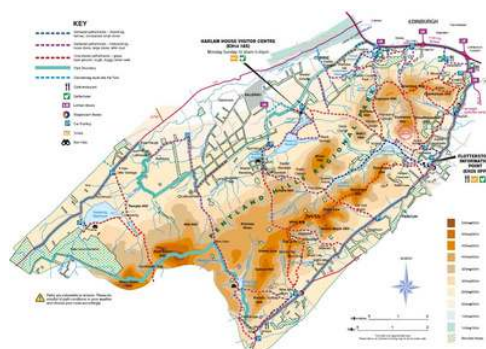
